

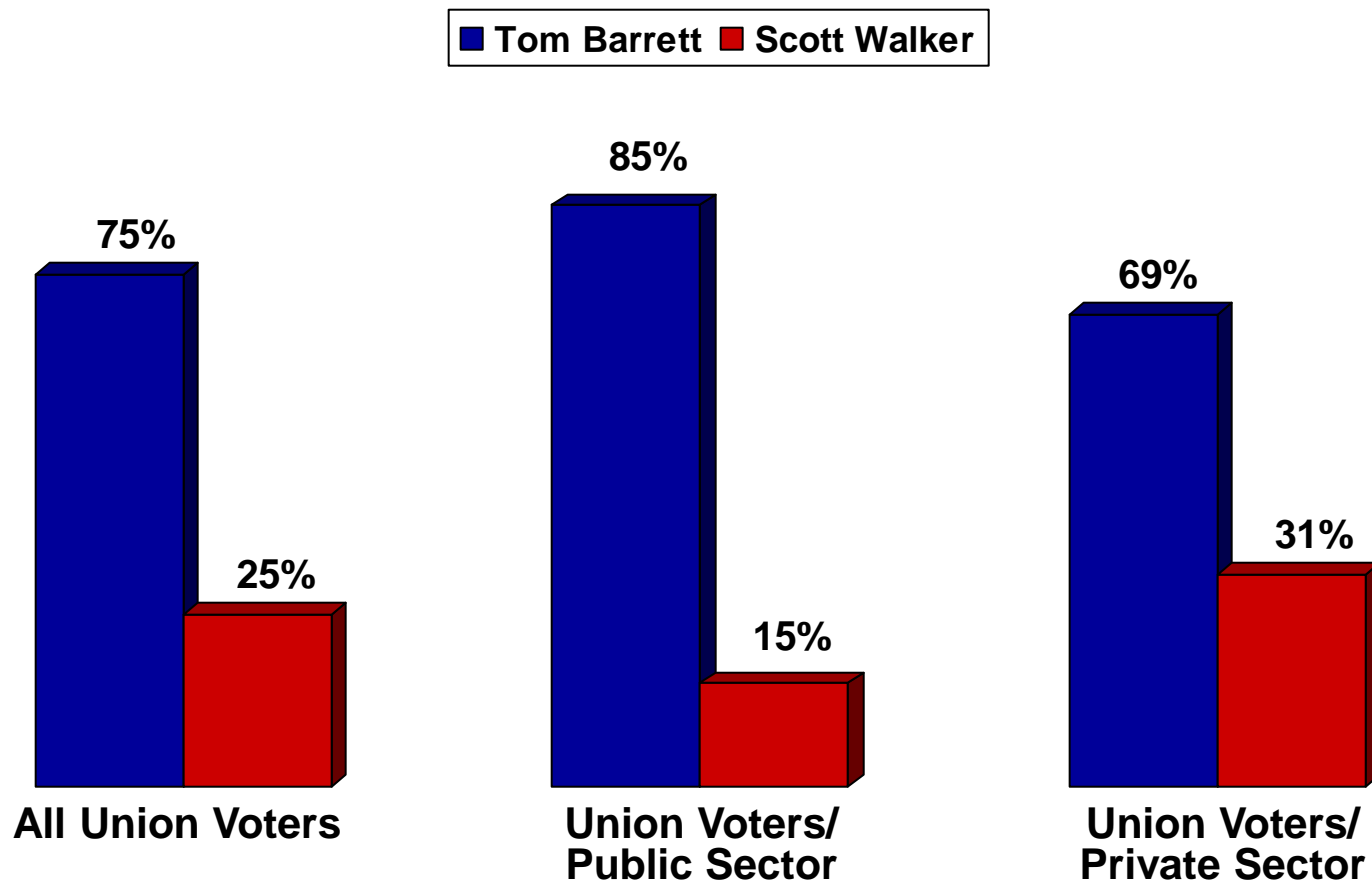


Wisconsin Recall Election Night Poll *Among Union Voters*

Public And Private Sector Union Members Overwhelmingly Voted For Barrett

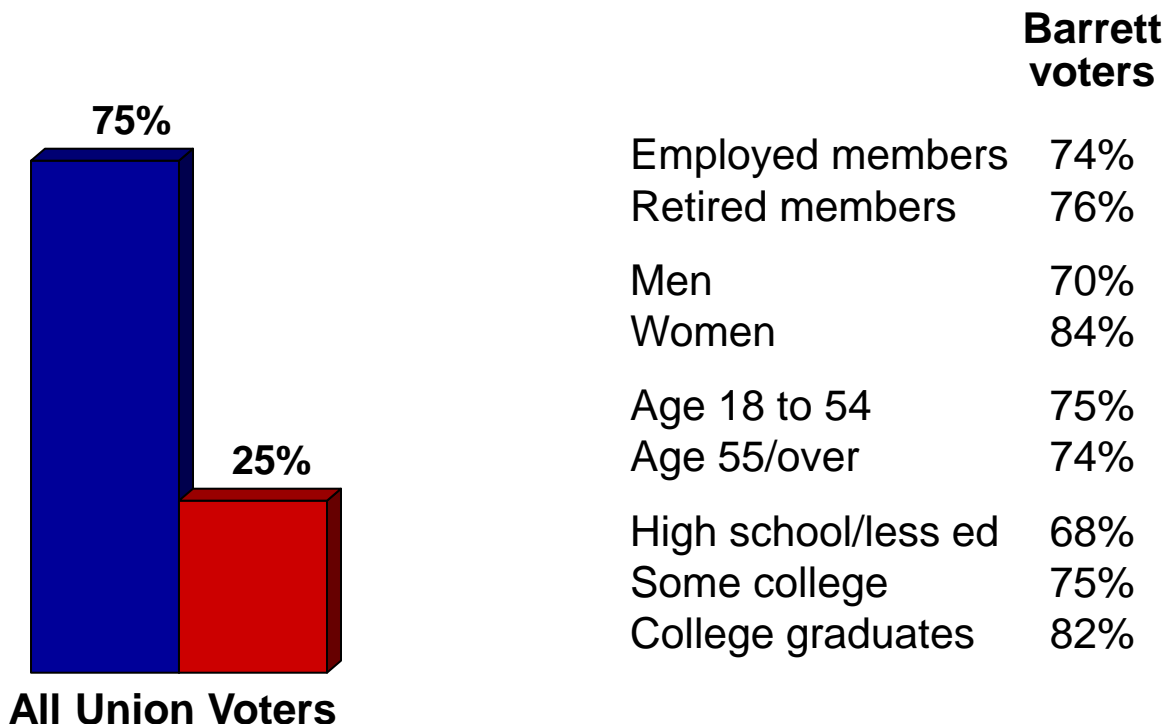
How did you vote in today's election for governor of Wisconsin?

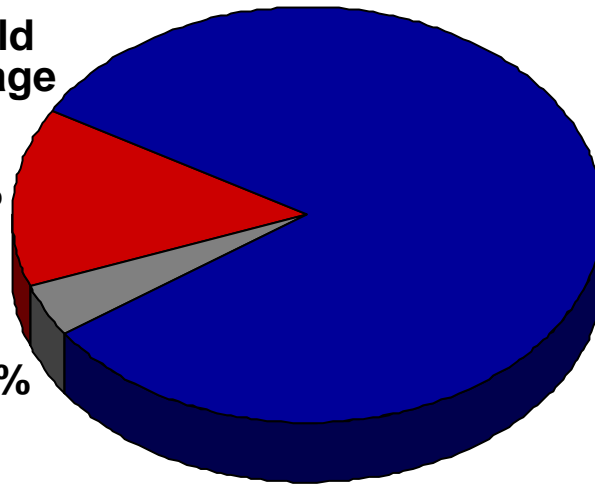


Union Voters Support Collective Bargaining Rights

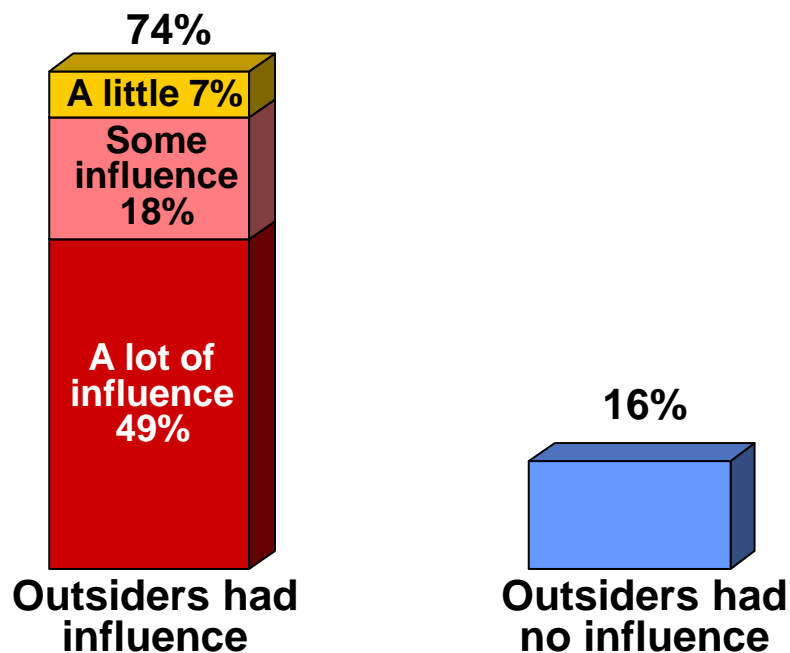
Public employees should be allowed to engage in collective bargaining over wages, benefits, working conditions

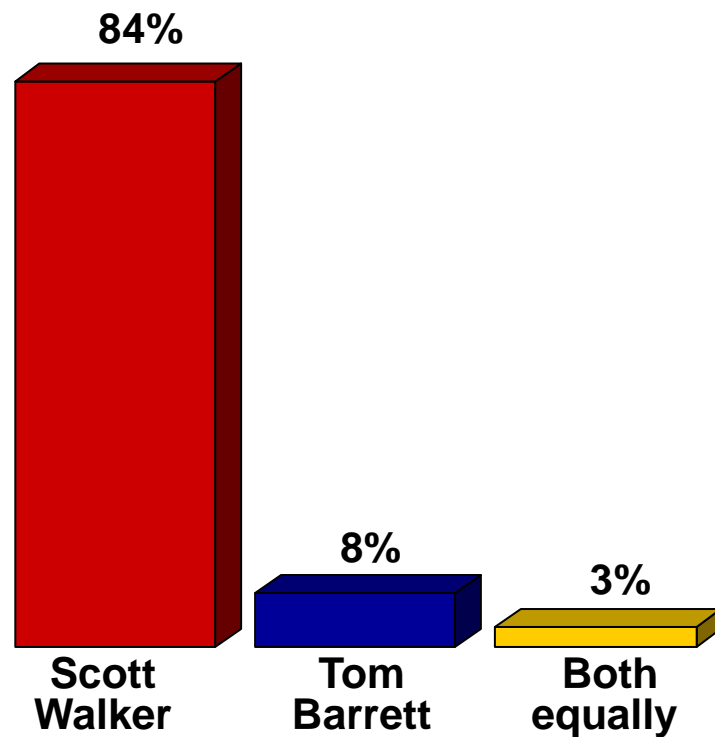
