This letter follows up on our letter dated June 12, 2020.


We understand the chief petitioners have submitted signatures in support of their petition. We trust the County will, as part of its verification process, take into account that the number of signatures collected is sufficiently high to call into question the validity of the collection effort.

As we have discussed, we believe the County failed to follow its code when permitting the collection of signatures on Multnomah County Initiative No. 8 before entry of the judgment.

The purpose of this letter is to reiterate that, if the County's acceptance of petitions signed before the entry of judgment results in the County's approving Multnomah County Initiative No. 8 for the ballot, an action will follow to challenge the approval.
